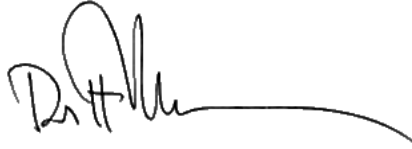
Dear Readers:
